## SPEECH OF HON'BLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE ON THE OCCASION OF FAREWELL OF HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE J.M. MALIK

During his tenure as a Judicial Officer, he worked in various capacities such as Magistrate, Sub-Judge, Rent Controller, Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Additional District & Sessions Judge. He was also the sole Member of Sales Tax Appellate

Tribunal, on deputation. Before his elevation to this Court he worked as

Judge In-charge, Karkardooma Courts.

During my brief tenure so far I have found Justice Malik to be a

sincere, hard-working and humane person. As a Judge of this court, his

contribution to the cause of justice will always be remembered and

cherished.

Justice J. M. Malik is parting company with us but only as a sitting

Judge of this Court. He shall always be in our hearts as a member of our

family. I am sure that even after retirement, he would always be eager to

lend his helping hand whenever this institution requires his services.

We wish him good health and a good long life. We also put on

record our deep appreciation for his contribution to the justice delivery

system of Delhi and particularly to this institution.
