Whereas the High Court of Delhi, by way of amendment, proposes to introduce an Explanation to Rule 106 of Order XXI of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (Central Act of 1908), which would read as under:-

In Rule 106, Explanation shall be added after sub-rule (3) as follows:-

“Explanation: An application may be admitted after the said period of thirty days if the applicant satisfies the Court that he had good cause for not making the application within such period.”

AND Whereas the objections, in writing, from any person, with respect to said amendments are invited within a period of one month i.e. 30 days from the date of which this Notification is published in the Delhi Gazette Extraordinary.
