In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 28 of the Right to information Act, 2005, read with Article 235 of the Constitution of India and all other enabling provisions, the High Court of Delhi hereby makes the following amendment in Delhi District Courts (Right to Information) Rules, 2008, which were notified vide No.162/Rules/DHC dated 6.5.2009 in Delhi Gazette Extraordinary, Part IV No.66 (N.C.T.D. No. 30) dated 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2009:-

### **AMENDMENT**

#### **I. Amendment in Rule 11**

**In Rule 11(a) the words “shall be accompanied by a fee of rupees fifty, except where the applicant belongs to 'below poverty line' category or the information asked for concerns life or liberty of any person, by way of cash against a proper receipt or by bank draft or bankers cheque or an Indian postal order payable to the District Judge and it” in between the words “of the Act” and “shall contain” stands deleted.**
