

CIRCULAR

In partial modification of this Court's earlier Circular No.87/CJS-III/Compt./2016 dated 17.05.2016, amended guidelines regarding complaints against members of the Subordinate Judiciary of Delhi are as under:-

- A. The complaint making allegations against members of the Subordinate Judiciary should not be entertained and no action should be taken thereon, unless it is accompanied by a duly sworn Affidavit and/or verifiable material to substantiate the allegations made therein.
- B. If action on such complaint meeting the above requirement is deemed necessary, authenticity of the complaint should be duly ascertained and further steps thereon should be taken only after satisfaction of the competent authority designated by the Chief Justice of the High Court.
- C. If the above requirements are not complied with, the complaint should be filed/lodged without taking any steps thereon.

The complainant, while making any complaint (s) in this Court against any of the members of the Delhi Higher Judicial Service/Delhi Judicial Service, is required to strictly observe the abovesaid guidelines.
